Using Payments

[How do I send or receive money in Messenger?](#)

You can send or receive money in Messenger (example: send your friend \$10 for lunch or receive \$500 from your roommate for rent) after you add a [US bank issued debit card](#) or a PayPal account.

Please note that you can only add PayPal as a payment method through the Facebook app on a mobile device.


To send money:

1. [Open a chat](#) with the person you want to send money to.
2. Click  then click **Next**.
3. Enter the amount you'd like to pay and click **Next**.

To receive money:

1. Open the conversation containing the money.
2. Click **Add Debit Card** in the conversation and add your debit card to receive money. Keep in mind your bank may take up to 3 business days to make the money available to you.
3. If you already have a debit card or Paypal account linked, or have received money through Messenger before, the money is transferred right away to the card or account on file, but your bank or Paypal may take up to 3-5 business days to make it available to you.
